

**Title:** Assistant Lecturer/Assistant Professor of Practice (Office of Teacher Education)

**Job Category:** Faculty

**Position Summary:** The Office of Teacher Education at Southern Illinois University Carbondale seeks applicants for one or more faculty positions. These are non-tenure-track, term, variable time positions beginning August 16, 2021 for the Fall 2021 semester. The positions will supervise pre-service teacher candidates in public schools, grades K-12 located in southern Illinois and/or teaching teacher preparation course(s) on campus. Academic rank is dependent on the degree held by the selected individual(s).

**Duties and Responsibilities:** The following pre-service teacher preparation (teaching and/or supervision) related responsibilities are conducted through the School of Education, Office of Teacher Education. Individuals could perform all or some of the responsibilities below.

1. Teach one or more courses attached to early clinical experiences or other requirements for teacher candidates.
2. Confirm placement of students assigned to designated K-12 schools.
3. Provide direct supervision and formative feedback to candidates during their pre-student teaching and/or student teaching clinical semesters.
4. Serve as a liaison between the SoE and the partner school districts.
5. Conduct evaluations of candidates during early clinical experiences and student teaching as appropriate.

**Minimum Qualifications:**

1. Applicants for the Assistant Lecturer rank must have completed a Master's Degree in a licensure area. Persons holding doctorates with specialty in instructional supervision and/or teacher preparation are preferred and will be hired at the rank of Assistant Professor of Practice.
2. A minimum of three years of successful teaching experience at the elementary, middle school and/or secondary level.
3. Experience in the use of rubrics to evaluate student or teacher candidate performance.
4. The teaching responsibilities require teaching experience with students with disabilities in P-12 special education school setting, and expertise in using technology to provide instruction, monitor student progress, and support professional development.
5. The clinical supervision position requires experience in instructional coaching and supervision or school-based clinical supervision.

**Preferred Qualifications:**

1. Professional involvement with several different grade levels and curricular areas.
2. Evidence of a record of building and maintaining strong relationships between public schools and the university in the area of educator preparation.
3. A commitment to undergraduate education, teaching excellence, and professional service.
